

**PET 5-POINT SCALE (DEAUVILLE CRITERIA)**

<b>Score</b>	<b>PET/CT scan result</b>
<b>1</b>	<b>No uptake</b>
<b>2</b>	<b>Uptake ≤ mediastinum</b>
<b>3</b>	<b>Uptake &gt; mediastinum but ≤ liver</b>
<b>4</b>	<b>Uptake moderately higher than liver</b>
<b>5</b>	<b>Uptake markedly higher than liver and/or new lesions</b>
<b>X</b>	<b>New areas of uptake unlikely to be related to lymphoma</b>
